CANADA ON FIRE FOR GOD

In my early Christian years, which would be about 40 years ago, I received a prophetic vision for Canada. While, at that time, I wrote it down, somehow, the original transcript of that vision disappeared, however, the vision stayed in my spirit. Over the years, verbally, I have shared the vision with many people. All affirm the vision and its interpretation witnessed as truth. After much thought, I decided to recap the vision from memory, thus creating a new transcript of it.



I am not sure of the date, but around 1982,¹ while praying, YeHoVaH opened my spiritual eyes to show me something remarkably interesting. He said to me, "Jeanne, what do you see?"² I said, "I see a maple leaf laying on the ground." YeHoVaH said to me, "What is wrong with that leaf? I looked closer. I realized there was never any life in that leaf because it had no veins in it. It was simply a large, flat leaf without veins.

Once I realized this, the vision began to change as YeHoVaH showed me several other things. First, He showed me a little girl approaching the leaf. In her

hand she carried a beach pail and shovel. She sat down on the ground beside the fallen leaf, and with her shovel began to dig into the ground close to the leaf, putting the dirt into her beach pail. Suddenly, she got up, grabbed her pail, and with shovel in hand, lifted the leaf and went under it, continuing to dig. I saw evidence of her beneath the leaf for a time but then, I saw it no more.



Next, there came someone a little older. With a sturdy adult shovel in their hand, they walked to an edge of the leaf. They positioned the shovel tip on the ground, placed their foot on the ridgetop of the metal blade, and with a solid thrust, sunk the shovel deep into the ground. As they continued to dig, they soon dug themselves beneath the leaf, disappearing from my view, just like the little girl. As the vision progressed, many more people came to every outside edge of that

leaf, all arriving with various items for digging. There were power diggers, backhoes and even

earth movers. Each person who approached the leaf, began to dig around the leaf's edge, and as they dug, they disappeared under it. As they worked beneath the surface, the leaf began to change. At first the difference was only minimal, but then, I saw veins forming within the leaf, coming from the underside. Some appeared near the top of the leaf, some near the sides and edges, and some near the middle and bottom. As I watched, I noticed that none of the veins linked together, but seemed isolated from each other. Suddenly, YeHoVaH spoke and as He did, the veins finished forming and all connected. Then, the leaf became engulfed in flames of fire, yet it did not burn.

YeHoVaH explained. People in the vision, those who came near the leaf to dig and disappeared under it, represent intercessors for the nation. Some, He said, approach the work like the child, who came with beach pail and shovel in hand. Others approach differently, like the ones who came with the larger shovel, backhoes, and earth movers. Each intercessor, with their specific assignment, whether large or small, contributes to the overall task at hand, working to see the realization of the plan of life for the nation. Then, He said, on the day I give the command, all the veins connect, and Canada becomes a flame of fire for Him.



It has been a long time since this vision, yet over the years, I have profited from its wisdom. I have learned that, as intercessors, we realize that our assignments often set the stage for future events. Nevertheless, we press hard against the principalities and powers of darkness and wickedness in heavenly places, following the direction of the Holy Spirit. In doing so, we remove our designated giants and take our appointed territories, which God assigned. While we may long to see *the total fruit* of our efforts realized quickly, as in all things, it comes in the season of God's choice. In the meantime, we walk in faith, pressing into God, following the Holy Spirit, praising Him for the results we see as well as the ones yet to come. As intercessors, we hold tight to the faithfulness of our God, trusting He does as He promised. Thus, as this vision assures us, whether we see it now or realize its manifestation in another season, we can expect to see:

Canada on fire for Him!
