## EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR DOCTOR OF THEOLOGY DEGREE:

For entrance into our doctorate degree program, we, first, require a recognized master's degree, which, of course, includes the bachelor's degree needed to obtain the master's degree. Beyond that, we require:

- 1. Candidates must speak, write and understand English (as our courses, at this point, are only in English)
- 2. **Candidates** must apply by filling out the application form. That application form requires *a* 500-word essay on the candidate's spiritual goals as well as the degree they seek.
- 3. Candidates, whose application is accepted, enter our doctorate degree program on a trial basis.<sup>2</sup>
- 4. **Candidates** who receive a 75% average of their first three courses<sup>3</sup> continue to earn their degree and receive the applicable credits towards their master's degree.<sup>4</sup>
